# Small Group Discussion Guide (Week of May 5, 2024)

Open your group with a time of sharing and prayer.

- I. The book of Philemon is referred to as one of Paul's *Prison Epistles*, probably written in his first imprisonment in Rome around 62 AD. Read *Acts 28:16-31*. What stands out to you on Paul's time in Rome?
- II. Now read <u>Philemon 1-7</u>. Summarize what we learn about Philemon from this passage. Verse 6 includes a prayer of Paul. How does sharing our faith tend to build our knowledge of God?
- III. Read <u>Philemon 8-11.</u> Who is Onesimus and what has happened to him? In what ways could he have come to be useful to Paul?
- IV. Read <u>Philemon 12-21</u>. What is Paul asking Philemon to do? On what is Paul basing his request? What debt might Paul be referring to in verse 18? Finish reading <u>verses 22-25</u>.
- V. Now, why do you suppose Paul doesn't denounce slavery? Notice his instructions to slaves and masters in *Ephesians 6:5-9, Titus 2:9-10*. See also *1 Corinthians 7:20-24*. Can we make any conclusions about slavery from these passages of Paul? Be specific.

\*Finally, what application can we draw from Paul's letter to Philemon?
